

How to perform a zoom in or zoom out operation

This could be achieved by using the Perfecto [gesture command](#).

Here is an example in Java:

```
Map<String, Object> params = new HashMap<>();
params.put("start", "20%,40%");
params.put("end", "15%,60%");
params.put("operation", "zoom");
params.put("duration", "3");
Object res = driver.executeScript("mobile:touch:gesture", params);
```
