

DevTunnel - How to open a shell on an Android device through ADB

Step-by-step guide

1. [Install DevTunnel](#)
2. [Connect to an Android device via DevTunnel](#)
3. Check that the device is connected by running the following command:

```
adb devices
```

Example:

```
sh-3.2# adb devices
List of devices attached
1c382024050b7ece    device
```

4. Open a remote shell on the device using the following command:

```
adb -s <deviceName> shell
```

Example:

```
sh-3.2# adb -s 1c382024050b7ece shell
starlte:/ $
```
